# Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt Participation Agreement

## Participant Agreement

I understand that the challenges, tasks and activities (“Challenges”) related to the scavenger hunt called Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt managed by Vancouver Pride Society are suggested activities presented with the understanding that the registered or unregistered participants engaging in these activities do so as volunteers, at their own physical, legal and mental risk. Vancouver Pride Society is not responsible for any injuries, damages or loss (financial or otherwise) that may occur in connection with participation in the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt or engaging in any of the Challenges.

I recognize and understand that Vancouver Pride Society does not intend for participants to violate any laws, regulations, or health guidelines (provincial or municipal) in connection with the Challenges.

I hereby assume full and sole responsibility for any and all risks of any physical or mental injury of any kind, including, but not limited to, injury, illness, death, and/or property damage suffered by me associated with my voluntary participation in the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt.



## Rules

The Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt will begin at 10am PDT and end at 11:59pm PDT on the dates specified on the Registration Form. During the event, teams of registered participants will compete against each other to create or find items, record the items created/found as images or videos, and submit these images or videos to the Vancouver Pride Society by the deadline.

Participants should not expose themselves or others to dangerous behaviour, or engage in any harmful or potentially harmful behaviour. The Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt is a skill-based competition and chance plays no part in winning.

To be eligible for participation, individuals must register through the online registration form and provide a contact name and email address for each member of their team. The deadline for registration will be 2 days prior to the start date of the event.

Participants 15 years of age or older, from any country may register and take part in the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt. Only participants with a current Canadian postal address are eligible to win prizes.

Minors must have permission from their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) prior to registering in the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt and indicate their status as a minor on the team's registration form. The Parent(s) or Legal Guardian(s) of the participating minor will be provided with additional documentation to complete during registration.

Eligible teams consist of 2, 3, 4, or 5 registered participants.

Eligible participants have the opportunity to win prizes as long as they have personally and actively participated as a part of an eligible team.



## Registration, Completion, and Submission Requirements

The link to the online registration form will be made available in advance of the event on Vancouver Pride Society's facebook event page and other online platforms. One person per team should complete the online registration form for their team, and insure all members have read and agree to this Participant Agreement prior to registration.

Teams should choose one Team Leader to correspond with the Vancouver Pride Society on the team's behalf.

The Team Leader will have the opportunity to contact the Vancouver Pride Society prior to, during, and after the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt for game support.

The Team Leader should be in contact with all members of the team, and will ultimately be responsible for submitting their team's entries (recorded Challenges) to the Vancouver Pride Society for review.

During online registration, teams have the option to gain additional team members (but only to top up their team to a maximum of 5) by having the Vancouver Pride Society assign additional members (participants). Teams and individuals who opt to be paired up by the Vancouver Pride Society must agree to share email contact details with one another.

## Completion of the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt

During the event, registered teams compete against each other to create or find the Challenge items (not limited to objects, art work, recipes, literary works, musical pieces, group videos, short productions) and to record these items. Recorded Challenge items may be in the form of a screen shot, photograph, manipulated photograph, short video, or written text, depending on the nature of the Challenge. The recording medium of each Challenge item will be indicated on the



Challenge List. The Challenge List will be emailed to each Team Leader on the first day of the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt.

Vancouver Pride Society may contact Team Leaders throughout the game week with additional Challenges, time sensitive Challenges and other opportunities to gain bonus points towards their total.

Team Leaders will be provided with a platform to upload their recordings during the registration period and should contact the Vancouver Pride Society immediately if they experience difficulties accessing the provided platform.

Teams will be awarded points for legitimate recordings based on creativity and accuracy in completing each Challenge. See scoring and prizes section below.

No entries will be accepted after the end date and time of the event, or if they are ineligible, or submitted on a platform not pre-approved by the Vancouver Pride Society.

## Challenge submissions

Challenge items and the recordings of them, must not contain obscene references, gang identification, personal information such as addresses, emails, or phone numbers, derogatory characterizations of any sexual orientation, gender, gender identity, gender expression, race, ancestry, place of origin, colour, ethnic origin, language, citizenship, creed, religion, age, marital status, physical and/or mental handicap, financial ability or other reasons covered by the BC Human Rights Code. Body shaming, or references to illegal behaviour or other inappropriate activity or behaviour are also condemned.



Content deemed unsuitable, inappropriate or offensive, is at the sole discretion of Vancouver Pride Society and may result in expulsion of the submission, participant or entire team.

Submitted recordings should be original works of the team as a group or of that team's individual participants. See Conditions of Submitted Content below.

Participants release and hold harmless Vancouver Pride Society from and against any and all claims based on publicity rights, defamation, invasion of privacy, copyright infringement, trade-mark infringement or any other intellectual property related cause of action that relates in any way to the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt use of the Challenge submissions.

## Scoring and Prizes

Each Challenge has a points value indicated on the Challenge List. Challenge submissions may be disqualified, awarded partial points, or awarded a full point value as determined by Vancouver Pride Society. Additional Challenges, Daily or time-dependant challenges, and/or other means of obtaining bonus points will be made available during the event and Team Leaders are encouraged to check their email regularly for these updates.

The Team that accumulates the highest point value from all Challenge list tasks and bonus Challenges will win the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt.

Prizes can only be awarded to participants with a current Canadian mailing address.

In the event that one (or more) individuals from the winning team do not have a Canadian address, their prize-eligible team mates will still be able to receive a portion of the prizes allocated.



Prize packs(s) are non-transferable or redeemable for cash and cannot be resold for profit. A maximum of 5 prize packs are available. The number of prize packs distributed will be determined by the number of eligible participants in the winning team.

Each individual prize pack (“Swag Bag”) has a value of CAD\$35.

Vancouver Pride Society is not responsible for, nor will replace any lost, stolen or expired prize. Prizes will be mailed by December 30, 2020 with winners notified by email and announced on Vancouver Pride Society social media (Facebook) during the week following the event.

Facebook does not sponsor, endorse or administer the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt.

## Consent to Contact

Participants must submit a valid email address during registration. The participant gives the Vancouver Pride Society consent to the collecting, storage and handling of their personal information, and consent to contact for up to 6 months from the date of registration, in regards to the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt only.

Entrants consent to the collection, storage, and handling of their personal information by Vancouver Pride Society is for the sole purpose of administering the contest and is in accordance with Vancouver Pride Society's privacy policy. Vancouver Pride Society's Privacy Policy can be found at

Upon submitting content during the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt, participants grant Vancouver Pride Society the right to use, reproduce, copy, publish, display, distribute, perform, translate, modify or otherwise exploit the Participant's content.

Participants must have the permission of ALL persons appearing in the videos and photographs to submit such material to the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt.

## Fees

There are no registration or participant fees to participate in the Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt.

## Cancellation

Vancouver Pride Society reserves the right to cancel the event (Vancouver Pride Scavenger Hunt) at any time, without warning, and without compensation to any registered or unregistered participant.

Vancouver Pride Society reserves the right to disqualify any participant if the Vancouver Pride Society believes that the person has violated any of the event rules, or is conducting themselves or has a history of conducting themselves in ways that don't align with the Vancouver Pride
